



Stainless Steel Wall Lights – Cleaning Guide

To keep your LED wall lights looking their best, like anything around your house it will require some general cleaning.

Stainless steel is a great product for outdoor use, but unlike normal steel it will not rust, but it can form surface rust which is commonly known as tea staining. If you do not remove this tea staining regularly then it can create more permanent damage to the fitting surface.

Following is our guide to ensure that your stainless steel wall lights look as good as the day they were installed.

- Step 1 Ensure the power is off to your lights
- Step 2 Start by giving the fitting a good scrub with a light kitchen scourer (non damaging type) with warm soapy water. You will notice the difference almost immediately.
- Step 3 After a good clean, if there are still any marks you may need to use a specific stainless steel cleaner that is readily available from your local hardware store (Bunnings or similar) in the BBQ cleaning aisle. Follow the instructions on the cleaner to restore the stainless steel.
- Step 4 Once the light is clean and completely dry, polish the light with some WD40 to assist in protecting the light and extending the time required between cleans.

S-Tech recommends cleaning your stainless steel light fittings 2-4 times per year.
